











HAZARD SYMBOLS

Many countries require Hazard Symbols labeled on the containers of chemicals .
These symbols have the following meanings:

<p>E: Explosive</p> 	<p>T: Toxic</p> 
<p>O: Oxidizing agent</p> 	<p>Xn: Harmful</p> 
<p>F++: Extremely flammable</p> 	<p>Xi: Irritant</p> 
<p>F+: Highly flammable</p> 	<p>C: Corrosive</p> 
<p>F: Flammable</p> 	<p>N: Dangerous for the environment</p> 
<p>T+: Very toxic</p>
